### Event: Avoiding Risk, Ensuring Quality

Walter O'Brien will present a deep dive into quantifying and mitigating all types of Risk to mission critical software in new ways. The presentation will include Artificial Intelligence software systems such as ScenGen that can think of, maintain and execute all possible tests on other systems even though they are constantly changing. He will also discuss risk scoring and future prediction of remaining defects and downtime. It even includes some Time Travel!

### About Walter O'Brien

Walter O'Brien (Scorpion) is the Chief Executive Officer and Founder of [Scorpion Computer Services](#). Walter serves as a member of the Board of Directors for the public renewable energy company American Environmental Inc. He is one of the world's leading experts in the application of computer science and artificial intelligence to solve industry challenges. He was born in Ireland and at the early age of sixteen ranked number one in national high speed computer problem solving competitions. At the age of eighteen he competed in the World Olympics in Informatics and has ranked as high as sixth fastest programmer in the world. He was a child prodigy with an IQ of 197. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence with honors from Sussex University.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security certified Walter as being of National Interest to the United States Economy and granted him an Extraordinary Ability EB 1-1 Visa (also granted to Albert Einstein and Winston Churchill). Walter has since become a US citizen. He recently completed a seven-year engagement with the largest mutual fund company in the US - Capital Group Companies (parent of the American Funds).
